Dear Parents of PK-2 students,

You may have noticed that the weekly folder sheet in your child's Tuesday folder has changed for PK-2 students. Klein ISD has implemented a standards based report card for PK-2. The new district Tuesday folder sheet has been created to provide you with information on a weekly basis on how your child is progressing on the standards being assessed for that nine weeks. In addition, it also provides you with information on how your child is performing within the Klein ISD Profile of a Learner which you can read about at https://drive.google.com/file/d/1jhl_X9uqXsvY5Z9Z4kP4J5x2qkSIJ2YM/preview.

The Klein ISD Tuesday folder sheet will be marked by the teacher when a standard has been assessed noting if your child has mastered that standard or *not yet* mastered the standard on the assessment. If a standard has not been marked, it means that the teacher has not formally assessed it, yet.
